

Gwent Ecology

Seddon House, Monmouth, NP25 4DY

Directions to the Gwent Ecology Offices

FROM THE M50 AND MONMOUTH

Follow the M50 and then A40 to Monmouth. As you continue on this dual carriageway past Monmouth, there are traffic lights – go straight over. About 200 yards after the traffic lights but before a tunnel, take the slip road B4293, signposted Monmouth and Trellech. At the T-junction, turn left and follow signs to Mitchel Troy. Follow the road through Mitchel Troy. Approximately ½ mile after leaving Mitchel Troy, take a left hand slip road signposted Dingestow (take care not to continue on the main road back onto the dual carriageway towards Newport).

After 1½ miles, take a right turn to Dingestow. In Dingestow, follow the road through the village and past the Post Office/Village Shop and the Village Hall. (The driveway to Seddon House is 0.8 of a mile from this Hall.) Follow this road as it bears sharply left and continue up the hill, out of the village. Go past the first driveway entrance to Dingestow Court.

After 0.8 mile from Dingestow Village Hall, the road bears sharply right, you'll see a lodge house opposite you, fronted by a small grass triangle with a tree and a left hand drive. Take this left hand driveway, marked with a sign for the Gwent Wildlife Trust. Follow the drive until you reach buildings. Before going through an arch in the main building, take a left through a stone wall. Seddon House is directly in front of you.

FROM THE M4 AND NEWPORT

Turn off the M4 at Junction 24 on to the A449. After about 12 miles, take the slip road for Raglan and Abergavenny. Merge with the A40 and then immediately turn right on to the road for Mitchel Troy (for which you will need to cross the dual carriageway).

After approximately 1½ miles, you will see a bus stop on your right and a bus shelter on your left. Turn left immediately following the bus shelter into a small lane, signposted Route 30 (a small blue National Cycle Route sign). This winding lane, which runs for ⅔ of a mile, ends at a T junction. Turn right at the T junction, then right again after ¼ of a mile, into the drive for Seddon House, marked with a sign for the Gwent Wildlife Trust. Follow the drive until you reach buildings. Before going through an arch in the main building, take a left through a stone wall. Seddon House is directly in front of you.

FROM ABERGAVENNY

Take the A40 to Raglan. At the roundabout, take the second exit, signposted A40 towards Monmouth and Newport. Turn left (after the castle) on to the road for Mitchel Troy. After approximately 1½ miles, you will see a bus stop on your right and a bus shelter on your left. Turn left immediately following the bus shelter into a small lane, signposted Route 30 (a small blue National Cycle Route sign).

This narrow and winding lane, which runs for 2/3 of a mile, ends at a T junction. Turn right at the T junction, then right again after ¼ of a mile, into the drive for Seddon House, marked with a sign for the Gwent Wildlife Trust. Follow the drive until you reach buildings. Before going through an arch in the main building, take a left through a stone wall. Seddon House is directly in front of you.
